DSP supported the EUSDR SK PCY in organising an online NC meeting (01/2021), NC-PAC meeting (03/2021) and PAC informal consultation on EUSDR roadmaps (03/2021).

**PACs** were supported by DSP in organising their online SG meetings (11&12/2020) as well stakeholder meetings and/or WG meetings (upon request).

DSP technically supported the organisation of **EuroAccess** webinars for the funding tool

### Documents





### Streamlined communication



DSP is the coordinating and connecting structure between countries & key implementers of the EUSDR acting as a **communication hub**. DSP supported the **EUSDR SK PCY** in preparing the further Embedding process and Discussion Paper.

DSP provides on a regular basis **information about MRS** (NC/PAC and NC-PAC meetings) and participated with the **EUSDR SK PCY** in the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the **MRS TRIO PCY** (03/2021). The DSP actively supported the 2<sup>nd</sup> **EU MRS WEEK** organised by the EC (03/2021) e.g. in the Cross embedding NDICI workshop. In addition DSP is member of the **INTERACT Working Group** (and its sub-WGs) including the regular exchange with other MRS in regards of the embedding process.







- Work within the MA & programming authorities networks (ERDF/CF & IPA/NDICI)





## f. What's next?

- **Ukrainian EUSDR Presidency**

Ukraine to be the first non-EU member state to chair EU Strategy for Danube Region (EUSDR) in 2022



On February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021, under the Slovak Presidency of the EUSDR and the unanimous decision of the EUSDR participating states towards the approval of Ukraine's chairing the EUSDR, Ukraine will hold the EUSDR Presidency from November 2021 to November 2022.

The Danube Region, like other EU macro-regions, faces challenges beyond borders – pollution, climate change, unemployment or lack of connectivity – that affect the lives of over 115 million people. To this end, the countries in the Danube basin came together and established the European Union Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR), identifying common needs, challenges

**Ukraine will hold the EUSDR Presidency from November 2021 to November 2022**

- approval of Ukraine's chairing the EUSDR Presidency on February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021, under the Slovak Presidency of the EUSDR and the unanimous decision of the EUSDR participating states
- Oleksiy Chernyshov, Minister for Communities and Territories Development of Ukraine:

*“Presiding over the Danube Strategy is a great responsibility for Ukraine and an opportunity to learn from the experience of other countries in the region. Each joint platform with the EU speeds up Ukraine’s European integration path, especially when it comes to co-operation within one of the largest regions in Central Europe”.*



## f. What's next?



- **EUSDR Strategic Projects/Processes OR EUSDR Flagships...**
  - Provide a **practical tool** for stakeholders and particularly the EUSDR participating states, to explicitly foster projects and processes with a strategic character;
  - Produce regional, national and international/transnational **visibility** for the EUSDR and its actions and targets while creating awareness among the general public and the EUSDR stakeholders;
  - Highlight the **progress achieved** in implementing the EUSDR and thus strengthening the internal and external **communication**;



## f. What's next?

- **EUSDR Strategic Projects/Processes OR EUSDR Flagships...**
  - **Strengthen a sector or branch**, or generating value chains or model solutions to important common challenges faced within the Danube Region;
  - Contribute to strong and clear **strategic focus** of the activities and efforts undertaken within the EUSDR Priority Areas as well as highlighting the ambition and direction a PA has in a certain policy area;
  - Support and further encouraging **cooperation** among EUSDR participating states and/or regions;
  - Strengthen the ground to further **embed** the EUSDR strategic topics – jointly agreed by all participating countries of the EUSDR – **into EU funding programmes 2021-2027 and beyond**;
  - **Promote the EUSDR** and – through the implementation of strategic projects and processes – the idea of transnational cooperation and **cohesion policy** in Europe and the Danube region.





## f. What's next?



- **EUSDR Strategic Projects/Processes – proposed scope and criteria**
  - Can be projects (single or grouped in clusters), processes, networks, platforms etc.
  - Can be planning/preparatory phase, in implementation/ongoing phase or completed



## f. What's next?

- **EUSDR Strategic Projects/Processes – proposed criteria**

- a) **Connection to the EUSDR:** Deliver on or contribute to one or more targets and Actions described in the EUSDR Action Plan.
- b) **Macro-regional dimension:** Involve at least three EUSDR participating states (or at least two participating states and a neighbouring country) and have a high macro-regional impact (effect) in at least three participating states from the Danube Region.
- c) **Multi-level governance approach:** Involve different actors (e.g. policy makers, policy implementers, research institutions, civil society etc.) and/or several levels (supranational, national, regional, local) in the development/consultation and/or implementation process.





## f. What's next?

### • EUSDR Strategic Projects/Processes – proposed course of action



#### Guidance paper for identifying and listing EUSDR strategic projects/processes

- Guidance paper – including definition, purpose and criteria for EUSDR strategic projects/ processes – drafted by the DSP in consultation with the PAs, endorsed by the NCs



#### Identification of EUSDR strategic projects/processes

- Selection of strategic projects and/or processes by PAs
- Submission of the EUSDR strategic project/process template by the PACs to the DSP
- Support and collection of templates from all PAs by the DSP



#### Labelling completed

- List of EUSDR strategic projects and processes on the EUSDR website, regularly updated and maintained by the DSP
- ‘Certificate’ for each EUSDR strategic project/process provided by the DSP
- Distribution of EUSDR strategic projects and processes among NCs and other EUSDR stakeholders by the DSP



#### Communication measures for more visibility

- Promotion of EUSDR strategic projects and processes by the DSP through website, social media, publications and/or other communication tools
- Potential promotion on national and transnational level by EUSDR stakeholders
