<u>Date of calls:</u> in April-May every year – **in 2018: 18th April**

Submission dates: 1st stage – June (2018); 2nd stage: January (2019)

Project starting date: next July after the submission (1st July 2019)

<u>Applicants and partners:</u> no territorial and institutional eligibility criteria – "any legal person registered in the European Union"

<u>Typical project:</u> 1,5-3 M € (no min. or max. budget); 2-5 years duration; 1-5 partner

Winning rate: 25%

INFORMATION ABOUT THE FINANCIAL RULES

Ratio of financial support:

> EU fund: max. 55 %

Own fund: min. 45 %

Available national co-financing (HU): max. the half of the own fund (~20 %)

Financial schedule:

	After signing the Grant Agreement	After 100% use of 1st pre-financing	After Final Report
No mid-term report	70%	0%	Max. 30%
1 mid-term report	30%	40%	Max. 30%
2 mid-term reports	30%	20%	Max. 30%

<u>Eligible costs:</u> personnel cost, travel, subcontracting, durable goods (equipment, prototype, infrastructure), consumables and supplies, land purchase or leasing, overheads, other

Large infrastructure and research activities are <u>not eligible!</u>





WHAT ARE THE NEW AND CRUCIAL ELEMENTS OF THE LIFE CALL 2018?

Maximum rate of EU contribution: 55%

2-stage application: only for Environment sub-programme (ENV, NAT, GIE)

- 1. concept note (~10 pages in English)
- 2. full proposal

More emphasis on:

- continuation, replication, transfer potential
- results-orientation, **measurable effects** (KPI key project-level indicators)

Synergies, multi-purpose approaches

Encouragement of further engagement of private entities ("close-to-market projects") Reduction of the number of project topics – more focus on EU policies and priorities







ENV - Thematic priorities for Water, including the marine environment – 1.

Water, floods and drought

- Implementation of flood and/or drought risk management actions –
 nature-based soliutions and/or prevention and protection tools and/or integrated
 risk assessment and management approaches)
- 2. Projects addressing hydro morphological pressures
- 3. Integrated management of nutrients and organic pollution
- 4. Reduction of pressures from **chemical pollutants**
- 5. Implementation of water saving measures

Marine and coastal management

- 1. Application of tools, technologies or practices to **ensure the sustainability of human activities related to the marine environment**
- 2. Projects aiming at **preventing and reducing marine litter or contaminants**, addressing them at the source at land and/or in the seas





ENV - Thematic priorities for Water, including the marine environment – 2.

Water Industry

- Technologies for drinking water and urban waste water treatment systems, through the use of resource efficient processes for the provision of water services, onsite procedures and/or control processes, to diminish or eliminate discharges of emerging pollutants and/or pathogens as part of wastewater treatment effluents
- 2. Tools ensuring the **resource efficient provision of water services** compliant with the Drinking Water Directive and the Urban Waste Water Directive to population living in **rural areas**
- 3. **Improvement of the efficiency and effectiveness** of solutions and/or treatment options regarding **recycled/reclaimed water**





GIE - Priority area Environmental Governance and Information – 1.

Information, communication and awareness-raising campaigns

• Raising awareness on environmental problems, EU environmental policies, tools and/or legislation among the relevant target audiences - benefits of the implementation of water legislation

Activities in support of effective control process as well as measures to promote compliance

- Improving environmental information systems operated by public authorities for electronically collecting, processing, storing and sharing environmental information, targeting eg.:
 - > river basin management plans and associated programmes of measures, analyses and reviews and/or
 - > marine spatial plans, and associated programmes of measures, and marine strategies with a view to ensuring synergies with Natura 2000 and river basin management plans and/or
 - **▶ flood risk management plans** and/or
 - **➤ nitrate action plans** and/or
 - decisions related to water pollution and water abstraction





<u>GIE - Priority area Environmental Governance and Information – 2.</u>

Environmental compliance assurance and access to justice

- Supporting environmental compliance assurance by developing and implementing or implementing existing cross-border, national or regional risk-based strategies to promote, check and enforce compliance regarding eg. diffuse and/or point-source water pollution and/or illegal water abstraction
- Promoting access to justice in environmental matters and/or mediation with a particular focus on eg. protecting nature, biodiversity and water quality via the nature, biodiversity and water instruments covered by LIFE thematic priorities
