

Improve the management capacity of Interreg programmes


Improve Interreg capacity in capturing and communicating results





Governance

- Coordinator's role differ in the Strategies
- Allocation of resources to the function
- Need to embed political level commitments in concrete actions (allocations and implementation) on the ground
- Setting-up steering/coordination groups is an exhaustive task
- Defining realistic targets that coordinators can achieve



Funding alignment

- Openness of funding sources to invest into macro-regional projects
- Added value and benefit for programmes
- Labelling
- Funding flexibility and differentiation of support
- Knowledge of funding sources
- Funding inclusive or exclusive?



Communication and visibility

- Communication and visibility of the work is in a core for the success
- Communication at all governance levels from the EU to local
- Common and simple terminology
- Shared approaches and similar ways of addressing questions
- Targeted information activities/campaigns





What is in a focus of the macro-regional strategy - policy development/change or project implementation?

Macro-regional process is:

an organised and inclusive long-term cooperation, implemented by blending different activities (networks, projects, tools), based on identified gaps and needs of the macro-region and aiming for greater policy impact and change of existing approaches
