

Not all EUSDR PA can be supported by the DTP






Indicative type of actions

- > **Development of common orientations, frameworks and strategies** in fields of transnational relevance where early policy development needed
- Preparation of transnational investments (infrastructure, equipment) to be subsequently financed through other sources
- Development and implementation of transnational tools and services (e.g. analytical, management, technical, monitoring tools)
- Pilot activities including small-scale investments (testing or demonstrating)
- Development and implementation of training and capacity building
- Accompanying information, dissemination, capitalisation and publicity measures

Specific Objective 2.1

Strengthen transnational water management and flood risk prevention

Specific Objective 2.1

Strengthen joint and integrated approaches to further develop and implement River Basin Management Plans in the Partner States in line with the overall Danube River Basin Management Plan in order to improve transnational water management and flood risk prevention contributing to the sustainable provision of ecosystem services.

Expected Results

Better integrated plans and developed solutions to further protect and enhance the status of all waters and to ensure the sustainable, long-term use of water resources in the Danube region strongly interlinked with sound flood risk management.

Result Indicator

Intensity of cooperation of key actors in the programme area in order to improve transnational water management and flood risk prevention

Specific Objective 2.1

Indicative actions

- implementation of appropriate techniques and practices for the improvement of waste water treatment level and efficiency;
- integrated **policies for the reduction of** the total amount of **pollution** entering the Danube river basin;
- > prevention of **groundwater quality** deterioration;
- > sustainable flood risks management to protect human life and property while encouraging conservation and improvement of water related ecosystems;
- transboundary implementation of the Flood Directive;
- proper fluvial and sediment management to track sediment transport and morphological changes;
- Implementation of **joint actions**, facilitation of **know-how transfer** and **capacity building** for sound water management through education and training activities.



1st Call open for all priorities

2 step procedure:

- > *First step* submission of Expression of Interest
 - Deadline: <u>3rd November 2015</u>, 15:00 CET
- > **Second step** submission of full Application Form by pre-selected project proposals (*estimated in April-May 2016*)

Project starts - estimated in a year time

Duration of project implementation: max. 30 months



Partnership

Requirements

- At least 3 financing partners from 3 countries of the programme area
- **Lead Partner from EU Member State** of Programme area

Eligibility

- **Public bodies/ bodies governed by public law** (including EGTCs)
- Bodies governed by private law (non-profit & profit making)
 - profit oriented
 - cannot be Lead Partner
 - only from EU countries (from non-EU countries not eligible)
- International organisations (under national / international law)
 - fulfil EU, programme and national requirements (control and audits)

Result oriented approach

- The contribution of the project to the respective programme result (and the related indicator) has to be clearly demonstrated
- Project activities and outputs have to be logically linked to the targeted specific objective







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
