The **priorities** of the Hungarian Presidency in 2019:


- finding ways to support the activities of the ICPDR by improving the financial framework, sponsoring system and partnership



EU WFD Implementation: Roadmap towards DRBMP Update 202er ational Commission for the Protection



- Significant Water Management Issues Report to be updated
 - including new chapter on alteration of sediment balance (sub-SWMI under HYMO)
 - to be discussed: climate change adaptation, water scarcity and droughts potential SWMIs?
- Danube River Basin Management Plan Update 2021
 - Data collection and preparation of plan input (structure and content of DRBMP-2021 to be discussed at RBM-49)
 - Questionnaires on EC national assessments with relevance for international level

Integration issues: Navigation



- 9th Joint Statement Meeting, Vienna, 13th to 14th September 2018
 - Particular focus for next meetings should be on environmental monitoring activities to assess the status of water bodies (also taking into account Article 4.7 WFD implementation) and sustainable technological solutions
- METEET activities (Mixed Environment Transport External Expert Team (METEET) are ongoing
 - Training mission conducted in Croatia and Serbia (2017/2018)
 - Call for interested countries and environmental experts is re-opened
 - Next Training mission in SK from 16th to 17th April 2019 in Častá Papiernička
- 10th Joint Statement Meeting, Budapest, 11th to 12th September 2019

Integration issues: Hydropower



- Guiding Principles available now in Bosnian, Croatian,
 Czech, German, Slovakian, Slovene and Ukraine language
- Draft Terms of Reference for Knowledge Base on Key
 Social and Economic Drivers for Sustainable
 Hydropower first results will be available prior to RBM-49
- Planned ICPDR Hydropower Workshop (2020)

Integration issues: Sturgeon activities



- EU Grant Feasibility Study Iron Gates to support for the Implementation of the Feasibility Study analysing options for fish migration at Iron Gate I & II (DG REGIO)
- AT Grant Ex-situ Facility Upstream Danube to finance an ex-situ feasibility study for the upstream Danube with a Grant of 95.000 EUR including the identification of potential locations for the "ex situ facility" in Austria/Slovakia/Hungary
- "MEASURES: Managing and rEstoring Aquatic bio-corridors for migratory fiSh species in the danUbe RivEr baSin" project
- DSTF Draft rules and procedures: DSTF has drafted revised Danube Sturgeon Task Force Rules and Procedures, which were open for comments by HoDs until end of September 2018; the ICPDR Secretariat compiled all comments in a consolidated version and shared it with the DSTF

Wastewater management



- Wastewater strategy for the DRB
 - World Bank specific activity on water management in the DRB, implementation supported by DWP 3rd phase
 - Funds allocated to develop a wastewater management strategy
 - Need for identifying other co-funding institutions and coimplementers beyond the core partners (EUSDR is welcome!)
 - Capacity building courses and training events on several topics for WWTP operators, municipality regulators and national administration people (financial and technical/operational aspects)
 - Mechanism for utilities (D-Leap of the DWP) potential activity for local and national administration (ICPDR, EUSDR is welcome!)

Sustainable agriculture



- Guidance document on sustainable agriculture
 - Elaboration in two steps (analysis of the knowledge base and guidance with recommendations) by end of 2019
 - First draft elaborated, updated version to be submitted to HoDs
 - Position paper on water & agriculture developed, consulted with HoDs and to be submitted to the RO EU Presidency
 - Participation in the EC water-agri workshop (February 2019, Bucharest)
 - Agri regional workshop with Sava Commission under DG ENV LIFE Grant, February 2019
 - ICPDR workshop in autumn 2019 in Budapest (5-6 November)

WWTP effluent monitoring

- Successful WWTP sampling campaign with SOLUTIONS, ongoing sample analysis (heavy metals: done, organic chemicals: in progress), finalization in summer 2019, joint reporting
- Planned point source effluent sampling within JDS4, on-going planning, follow-up/complementary with SOLUTIONS
- Project development on HS emissions
 - Prep project (DSPF) implemented to develop a project proposal
 - Consortium, draft technical proposal and Eol elaborated and submitted to DTP3 (with EUSDR support)

Accident prevention



- Accident Hazard Sites
 - Data revision and fine tuning is on-going (imbalances of reported data), harmonized reporting criteria, to be published in 2019
 - Public documents (technical report and brochure) being elaborated on accident prevention & control with the PP EG
- Tailings management facilities
 - Project from LIFE Grant, risk assessment to develop a TMF inventory, data collection and evaluation finished, being approved
 - UBA Germany Grant Project started on capacity building, training event in RO in 2019-2020 regional demonstration events to be organized for operators and inspectors, second phase in 2020-2021 in the Sava region, follow-up national programs (EUSDR!)

Joint Danube Survey 4



- Providing comparable and reliable information on selected water quality elements (spatial snapshot)
- To provide a basin-wide platform for knowledge transfer on harmonizing and improving monitoring practices
- New concept to be applied based on a more active participation of the countries and using more effective and flexible logistics
- Survey and its tasks to be mainly accomplished by national experts
- Core Team established with coordinating and advisory role to ensure the coherence between the approaches used (training workshops to ensure comparable results)
- Start: 28 June 2019, ceremonial event in Budapest (after the 17th StWG Meeting), reporting: end of 2020
