International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River

- Germany taking over the annual Presidency of the ICPDR
- New President: Mr Helge Wendenburg, Director General, Dep. Water Management and Resource Conservation, German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety
- Three main priorities for 2018:
 - promote adaptation to climate change
 - take the next steps in the implementation of the WFD and the Flood Directive
 - strengthen the integrated approach and the basin-wide exchange of experiences

Interim Report on the JPM Implementation 2018

- Report more appealing to the public
- Printed concise publication of about 20 pages including **10 key messages**

- Main messages: progress in the implementation of the WFD in the DRB over the least years
- Focus on measure implementation rather than technical figures
- Messages supported by data collection showing progress and by exemplary best-case measures (lighthouse projects, success stories)
- Short outlook including gaps, remaining challenges and future tasks to be implemented until 2027
- Target audience: **broader public** (not only water people)

EU LIFE Grant

- EU LIFE Grant to support implementation of the 2nd DRBMP and 1st DFRMP
- Duration of **21 months**, started on 1 September 2017 (180.000 EUR Grant contribution, 52.26%)
- Existing knowledge gaps and strengthen capacities to be addressed

 - ICPDR, WB, IAWD and JRC main organizers; Apele Romane – host; EC, EUSDR, GWP, EIB - support
 - Topics: financing & investment, management & operation, technology & innovation
 - Around 120 experts and stakeholders
 - Presentations and report available on Danubis
 - Further discussions on a regional wastewater strategy and follow-up activities

Sustainable agriculture



International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River

- Guidance document on sustainable agriculture
 - Knowledge base finished (policy implementation and agro-economy)
 - Core team established on water and agriculture (agri experts from AT, HU, HR, RS and RO, WWF, WIFO)
 - Drafting the guideline in summer 2018 (topics, objectives, principles)
 - Planned workshop in autumn/winter 2018 in cooperation with the EC end EUSDR

Cooperation with SOLUTIONS Project

- Successful WWTP sampling campaign with SOLUTIONS (organic emerging chemicals, heavy metals)
- On-going sample analysis (heavy metals: done, organics: in progress)
- Project development on HS emissions
 - Pre-study on data availability, modelling and project concept development finalized
 - Follow-up project funded by DSPF to further investigate national situations and to prepare a proposal for large project preferably to be submitted to DTP3

Accident prevention



International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River

- Technical report on risk assessment to be fine tuned, expected finalization by end of 2018 (ARS), CS to be continued
- Public report and leaflet being elaborated on accident prevention and control (planned publishing in spring 2019)
- Tailings management facilities (TMF) small project on risk assessment on-going financed by the ICPDR
- TMF training events in RO and RS in 2019-2020 for operators and inspectors to be financed by UBA Germany

Hydromorphology

- Danube Floodplain Project
 - Reducing the flood risk through floodplain restoration
 - Accepted for funding under DTP2
- GEF "Danube River Basin Hydromorphology and River Restoration (DYNA)" Project
 - Addressing HYMO issues in non EU-MS in the DRB
 - Kick-Off Workshop organized on 12 March 2018, implementation to be started early 2019
- Workshop on financing HYMO measures planned back to back with 20th HYMO Meeting in Bucharest at the end of September 2018

Sturgeon conservation

- ICPDR Sturgeon Strategy approved at OM-20 (comprehensive overview of actions and measures to be taken by all partners)
- Sturgeon communication strategy being discussed by PP EG and integrated into the overall strategy
- Current work on DG REGIO Grant application for Support for the Implementation of the Feasibility Study analysing options for fish migration at Iron Gate I & II (envisaged start in July 2018)
- European Sturgeon Conference (9-10 July 2018 in Vienna) being organized by AT EU Presidency and ICPDR
- MEASURES project proposal (managing aquatic bio-corridors for migratory fish species) accepted for funding under DTP2
