
Danube Strategy



The area covered by the EU Strategy for the Danube Region stretches from the Black Forest (Germany) to the Black Sea (Romania-Ukraine-Moldova) and is home to 115 million inhabitants. (Danube River Basin: 80 million)

EUSDR adopted in 2011

Based on macro-regional cooperation is a sense of regional identity, common strategic planning and unification of financial sources: the actions proposed address the goals of developing sustainable use of resources and contribute to the goals of Europe 2020 targets.



Key players and roles DANUBE REGION STRATEGION




PA4 - setting the scene



- Main objective: to restore and maintain the quality of waters.
- Main challenges/significant water management issues: organic and nutrient pollution, hazardous substances pollution, hydromorphological alterations.
- > Tools of implementation:
 - √ cooperation with relevant institutions, policy-making,
 - √ alignment of funding,
 - √ facilitate project implementation as well as the set up of project consortiums,
 - √ publication of the main results.

The ICPDR provides the **legal basis of cooperation** in the entire field of water management undertaken in the context of the DRPC within its legal mandate also to carry out relevant tasks outlined in the EUSDR Action Plan.

EUSDR PACs, based on their mandate, coordinate activities in their respective PAs also by ensuring strong cooperation and mutual reinforcement with existing institutions, avoiding duplication or overlapping of activities.

- EUSDR team of PA4-PA5 participate at WGs of ICPDR
- PACS participate at key ICPDR meetings
- PA4-PA5 projects and researches are being introduced at WGs of the ICPDR
- PA-PA5 asked the coordinated opinion of ICPDR and its WGs for the issue of alignment of funding and JOINT PRIORITIES
- COOPERATION is progressing further, joint notions are clear.



The ,targets' of PA 4

- Achieve the management objectives set out in the Danube River Basin Management Plan;
- 2. Reduce the nutrient levels in the Danube River to allow the recovery of the Black Sea ecosystems to conditions similar to 1960s;
- 3. Elaborate a Danube Delta Analysis Report as a step towards completion of the Delta management Plan;
- **4. Elaborate, adopt and implement sub-basin management plans**, such as Sava, Tisza and Prut sub-basins
- 5. Secure viable populations of Danube sturgeon species



Focus on the following topics

- strengthening sub-basin activities,
- facilitate the efficiency of waste water treatment in the basin (specific focus on non-EU countries),
- challenges in relation to hazardous substances, and substances that are problematic for Danube Regions,
- better integration of agriculture sector in water management (strengthening cooperation with agri sector),
- updated solutions in the assessment of new sustainable human development activities towards the Danube Region development (in accordance with the Article 4.7 of the WFD – 2000/60/EC),
- river continuity interruption (reintroduction of sturgeon species in the Danube and its tributaries and sediment issues).







- Idea of EUSDR PA4 and was organized jointly by EUSDR PA4 and Interact on 19 April 2018 in Budapest
- All 4 macro-regional strategies participated and presented their water related activities and approaches (EUSDR PA4, 5, 6, Baltic, Alpine, Ion-Adriatic) + DG ENV, EG REGIO
- Interesting to see the different approaches / priorities of the strategies
- Roundtable discussion identified similar and different approaches on funding, stakeholder involvement and policy impact of activities and identified themes that could be subject to further cooperation
- Agreement on the usefulness of further common work more detailed study will be elaborated based on the results of the workshop still this year and then a kind of task force established next year.


Planned for 2019
