Horizon 2020 "Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials"



- > **Thematic objectives to be supported by the programme and its assimilation to the EUSDR priority areas:** Building a low-carbon, climate resilient future: climate action in support of the Paris Agreement; Greening the economy in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Available budget per categories to be supported: 2018: 703,5 mEUR, 2019: 762,95 mEUR, 2020: 643,95 mEUR
- Expected date of calls, submission dates: opening: 7 November 2017, deadlines: 27 February, 2018 (1st stage), 4 September, 2018 (2nd stage), 19 February, 2019 (1st stage), 4 September , 2019 (2nd stage)
- > Eligible partners: praticipants from Member States, Associated States, Third Countries
- > **Typical project size (budget) and duration:** budget: varies from topic to topic, duration: varies, most common 3 years
- Expected oversubscribed based on the experiences: Average success rate for the whole of Horizon 2020: 11,6%, it varies from programme to programme

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Information about the financial reporting/accounting



- > **Ratio of financial support:** 100% (except for Innovation Actions where it is 70%)
- > **Financial schedule:** pre-financing is available but there is no standard amount, the amount is fixed in each Grant Agreement
- Eligible costs: personnel costs; direct costs of subcontracting; other direct costs; ineligible costs: costs related to return on capital; debt and debt service charges; provisions for future losses or debts; interest owed; doubtful debts; currency exchange losses; bank costs charged by the beneficiary's bank for transfers from COM; excessive or reckless expenditure; deductible VAT; costs incurred during the implementation of the action
- > **Rules of self-contribution:** Consortium Agreement, timesheets, work packages

Submission procedure



- > **Submission process:** electronic submission through the Participant Portal, evaluation by external evaluators, TTG: 8 months
- Project proposal preparatory process, available information and documents: all information on the Participant Portal: <u>http://ec.europa.eu/research/participants/portal/desktop/en/home.html</u>
- Relevant thematic and formal specifications, expected structure of the proposal: templates Participant Portal
- > **Requirements towards the applicant:** in topic descriptions Participant Portal
- > **Factors increasing/decreasing the success:** fulfilling the call criteria as per description
- > **Expected/suggested indicators:** *evaluation criteria:* excellence, impact, implementation
