PA4: Biodiversity and environment International SAVA RIVER BASIN COMMISSION status of sediment, water and biota in SRB

- Towards the assessment of ecological status of water bodies in the Sava River Basin- STAWA
 - The final report was uploaded via online tool in mid April 2016
 - Close cooperation with project GLOBAQUA
 - Main aims
 - To identify linkages between stressors in multiple stressor situations,
 - > To **assess their effects** in the chemical and ecological status
 - > To **improve water management** practice and policies

Sava River Basin as one of the project study sites.


Timeframe: 5 years project: started in Feb. 2014



PA4: Establishment of Sava GIS

- Sava GIS established:
 - a common platform for sharing and disseminating of information and knowledge about protection of the water resources and water management activities in the SRB
 - Initial functionalities of Sava GIS for River Basin Management and Flood protection (available on http://savagis.org)
- Sava Hydrological Information System (Sava HIS):
 - real time and historical data

Other projects/activities


- Sediment management
 - Protocol on sediment management ratified by BA, HR and RS
 - Towards practical guidance for sustainable sediment management using the Sava river basin as a showcase
 - Establishment of sediment monitoring system in SRB
 - Proposal (available on http://savacommission.org/project_detail/20/1)
 - On-going activities (supported by UNESCO Venice Office):
 - Installation of equipment for continuous measurements of SS concentration
 - Upgrade of SavaHIS
 - Programme for development of SSMP
 - Workshop on sediment management, monitoring and modelling





INTERNATIONAL SAVA RIVER BASIN COMMISSION

- Consideration of intersectoral linkages (water, food, energy, navigation, tourism, environment)
 - Sava Nexus Assessment (UNECE Water Convention) - finished
 - Drina Nexus Assessment
 - Purpose:
 - ➤ to foster transboundary cooperation by identifying intersectoral synergies;
 - determining measures that could alleviate tensions related to the multiple needs.
 - 2 workshops organized
 (April 21-22 in Podgorica (ME) and Nov. 8-10 in Belgrade (RS))
 - Final report under finalization

Water Pollution Contingency Management System

Project proposal submitted to DTCP


- LP: University of Ljubljana (SI)
- Main objective:
 - to address the improvement of current operational status of APC in Sava and Tisza basins
- Outputs
 - on-line pollution lead-time model

The project proposal was not selected for co-financing!



PA5: Flood management

- 'WBIF project'
 - Sava FRM Plan (Tender procedure in progress)
 - Sava Flood Forecasting and Warning System (Initial phase finnished)
- Upgrade of models (USACE support 2nd phase)





Public Participation

- Strengthening public participation and stakeholder involvement in the SRB – supported by US Government
 - Establishment of Sava Water Council
 - O Purpose:
 - Strengthening active involvement of civil society in water management process
 - Transfer of ownership to civil society
 - Advisory body ("think tank") of ISRBC
 - Stakeholders from NGO, academic and business sectors (55 institutions)
 - Two meetings were held (Belgrade (RS), Feb.18-19 and Sevnica (SI) June 6-7, 2016)
