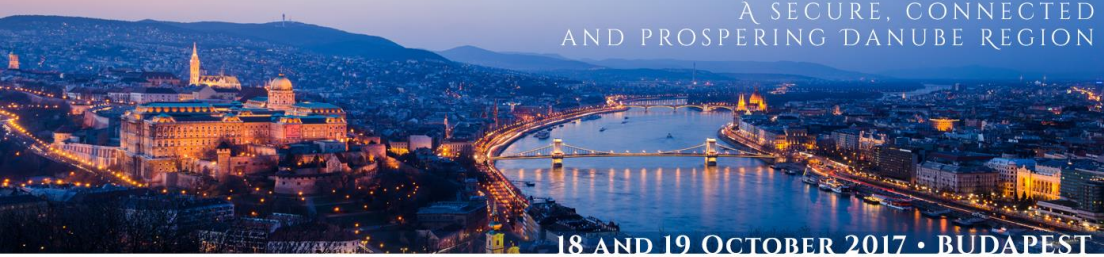

- Priority areas and thematic objectives to be supported by the LIFE programme and its assimilation to the EUSDR priority areas

Environment sub-programme priority areas	Budget 2017	Budget 2014-2020
Environment and Resource Efficiency (ENV)	83 M €	495 M €
The ENV priority area will develop, test and demonstrate approaches, best practices, solutions and integrated approaches to environmental challenges, as well as improving the related knowledge base		
Nature and Biodiversity (NAT)	101,9 M €	610 M €
The (NAT) priority area will develop, test and demonstrate best practices, solutions and integrated approaches to contribute to the development and implementation of nature and biodiversity policy and legislation, as well as improving the related knowledge base		
Environmental Governance and Information (GIE)	16,9 M €	163 M €
The GIE priority area will promote awareness-raising on environmental matters, support the communication, management and dissemination of environmental information, and promote better environmental governance by broadening stakeholder involvement		

General characteristics of the LIFE Programme

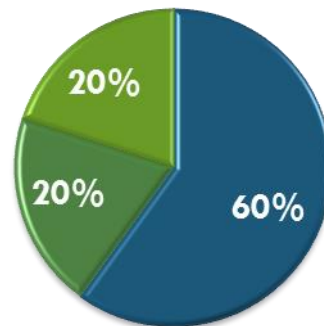
- Date of calls: in April-May
- Submission dates: in September
- Project starting date: next July after the submission
- Applicants and partners: no territorial and institutional eligibility criteria – „any legal person registered in the European Union,,
- Typical project: 1,5-3 M € (no min. or max. budget); 2-5 years duration; 1-5 partner
- Winning rate: 25%

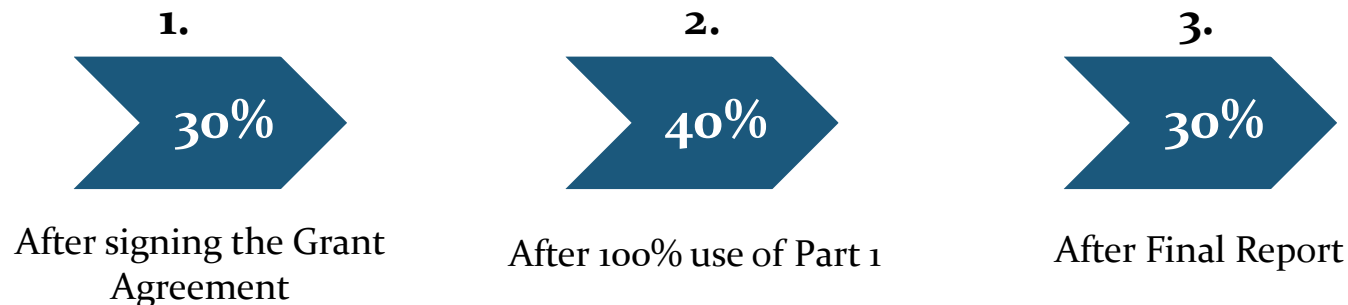

- Financial schedule:



- Eligible and non-eligible costs: personnel cost, travel, subcontracting, durable goods (equipment, prototype, infrastructure), consumables and supplies, land purchase or leasing, overheads, other,
- Large infrastructure or research activities are not eligible
