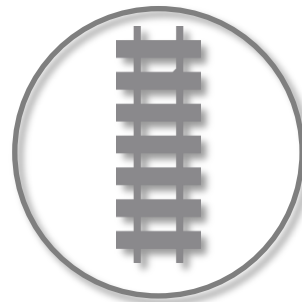

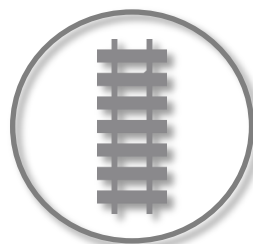

- 1st DTP Call – **54 projects** approved & under implementation
- **4 projects** in connection to water and environmental risk management
- 2nd DTP Call – 127 applications – 7 + 6 water / environmental risk relation (under assessment)

- **integrated territorial approach** – partnerships involve mixed sectorial actors
- projects, outputs, results **not to be „isolated”**

fill knowledge-gaps by linking actors with complementary thematic expertise, geographical scope

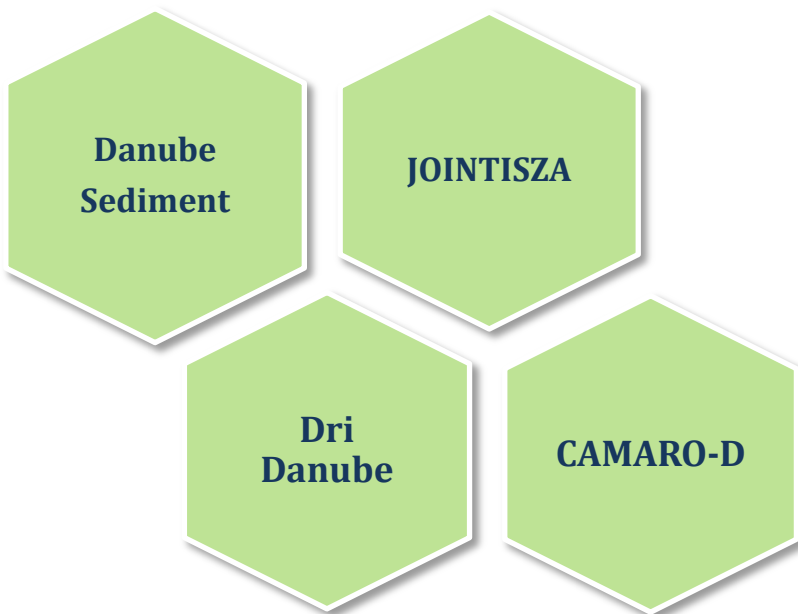
increasing visibility of projects and the programme to **ensure impact on policy making process**
