Policy developments

> **Strategic cooperation** with

- > DG Regio –" daily" working relationship in
 - Governance of PA 4 (with contribution of DSP)
 - Reporting issues (controlling of progress)
 - Technical assistance providing
- > DG Enviro implementation of environmental policies through
 - Unit of "Cohesion Policy and Environmental Impact Assessments"
 - Unit of "Water"
- > Danube Strategic Point supporting the COM in its coordination task

Joint cooperation with

- > ICPDR (Joint Paper)- clarification of technical and political roles for better implementation of water management objectives
- > SAVA Commission PA 4 ICPDR (Trilateral Cooperation) work-plan harmonization
- > Carpath Convention (Joint Declaration) strengthening cooperation for Tisza River sb
- JRC (In-house Science Service) Danube Water Nexus building



Governance *

- > **SG meetings** (for ongoing exchange of information & enhance of cooperation)
 - > 10 work meetings already done under commonly adopted RoP
 - Tangible improved activities of the SG members
 - Application of the written procedures out of/between meetings
 - > Help in financing issues of non-EU countries for taking part in SGs
 - Mobilization efforts among SG members
- > Supporting of Pillar B/PA 4 relevant project proposals through
 - > LoR- donations in 15 cases
 - LoM donations in 3 cases
- > Non EU country visits for managing Water imbalances in the Danube region (UA, RS, BiH, MD)
- Strengthening sub-basin initiatives (some parts of the territories are out of EU MSs)
- Continuous website management (<u>www.danubewaterquality.eu</u>)

ACHIEVEMENTS AND ISSUES TO BE PROCEEDED FURTHER DANUBE REGION strategy PA4 "To restore and maintain the quality of waters"



Progress by targets

- > Achieve the management objectives set out in the Danube River Basin Management Plan ("improvement of Water Status");
- > Reduce the nutrient levels in the Danube River to allow the recovery of the Black Sea ecosystems to conditions similar to 1960s ("limitation of discharge");
- > Elaborate a Danube Delta Analysis Report by 2013 as a step towards completion of the Delta management Plan which shall be adopted by 2015 ("measures for the biggest wetland of EU");
- Secure viable populations of Danube sturgeon species (habitat protection);
- > Elaborate, adopt and implement the sub-basin management plans, such as Sava, Tisza and Prut sub-basins (**strengthening of sub-basin initiatives**);

Fulfil PA 4 Actions

- > Actions are not needed for revision
- Upgrading of Road Maps (timetables)



> Projects

- > **Flagship projects of PA 4** (submitted to DTP)
 - > Danube SEDIMENT Management Restoration of the sediment balance in the Danube River
 - > JOINTISZA Strengthening cooperation between river basin management planning and flood risk prevention to enhance the status of waters of the Tisza River Basin
- > Some other PA 4 importance project proposals (with LoR)
 - Utilisation of Unique Wetlands and Lakes in Undermined Areas
 - > Development of Urban Wastewater Treatment plants in Transcarpathian region, Ukraine
 - > Innovative and Eco-friendly Irrigation technologies against CC impacts
 - > Sustainable Sanitation in Small settlements of the Danube region
 - Eco-innovation in waste water treatment for Removing of Pharmaceutical Residuals
