From the railway stations:

Keleti railway station: M4 metro to Szent Gellért tér

Nyugati railway station: 4 or 6 tram Petofi Bridge Buda side

Déli railway station: 18 tram Szent Gellért tér

Kelenföld railway station: M4 metro to the Szent Gellért tér (or 153 bus Petofi Bridge Buda side)

From Liszt Ferenc Airport (Ferihegy):

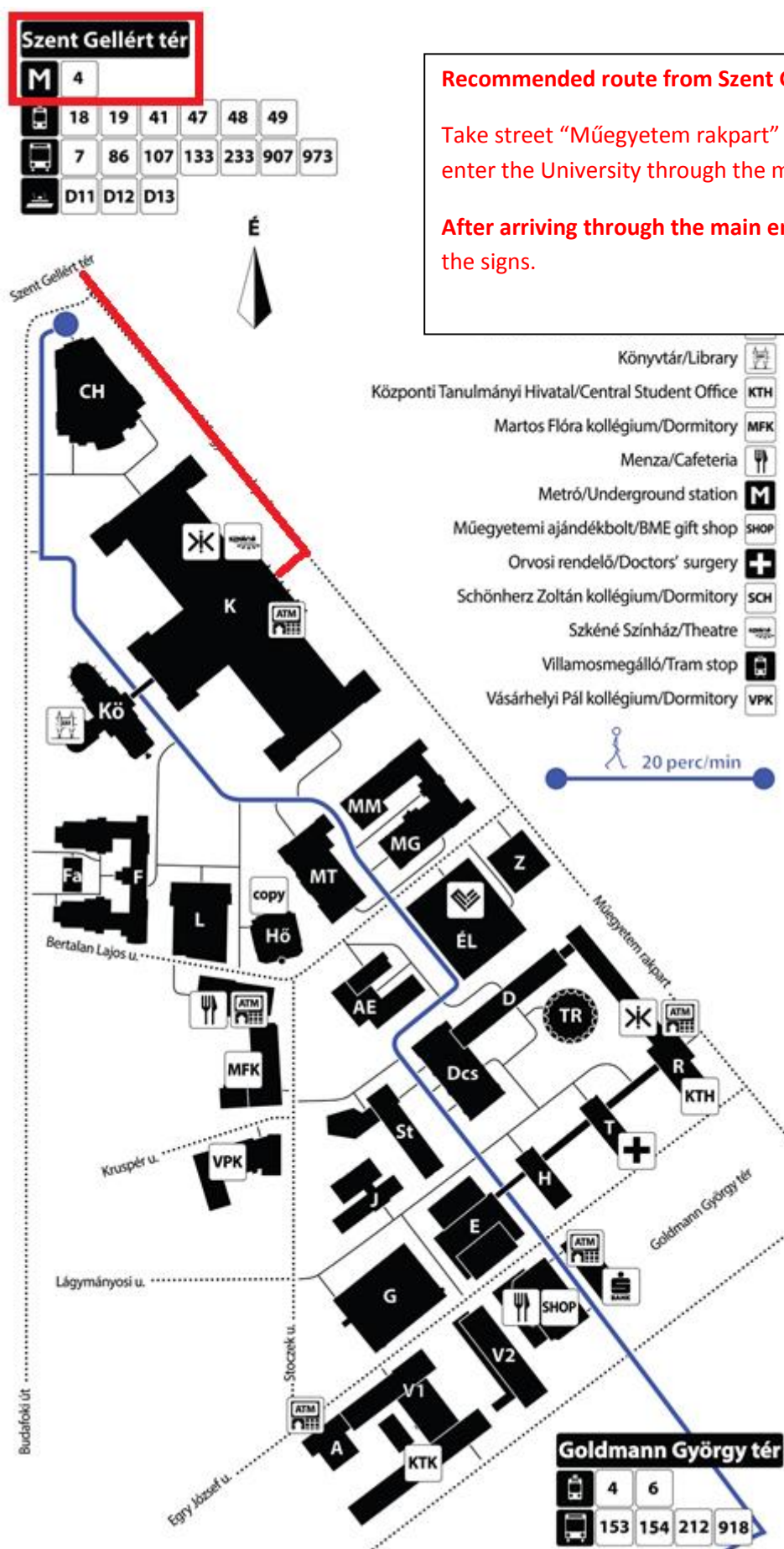
Bus 200E to Kőbánya-Kispest metro station, on the M3 metro Ferenc körút, Tram 4 or 6 to Petőfi Bridge Buda side (or one of the airport minibuss service with flights)

On motorways:

M1 (E60, E75), M7 (E71): M1-M7 - Budaörsi út - Nagyszőlős utca - Bocskai út - Október 23 utca – Irinyi József utca – Műegyetem rakpart

M3 (E71) M3 - Hungária körút - Kálman körút - Rákóczi híd (Rákóczi bridge) - Pázmány Péter sétány - Műegyetem rakpart

M5 (E75) M5 - Nagykőrösi út – Gyáli út - Kálman körút - Rákóczi híd (Rákóczi bridge) - Pázmány Péter sétány - Műegyetem rakpart



Recommended route from Szent Gellért tér:

Take street "Műgyetem rakpart" towards South;
enter the University through the main Entrance.

After arriving through the main entrance: Follow the signs.
