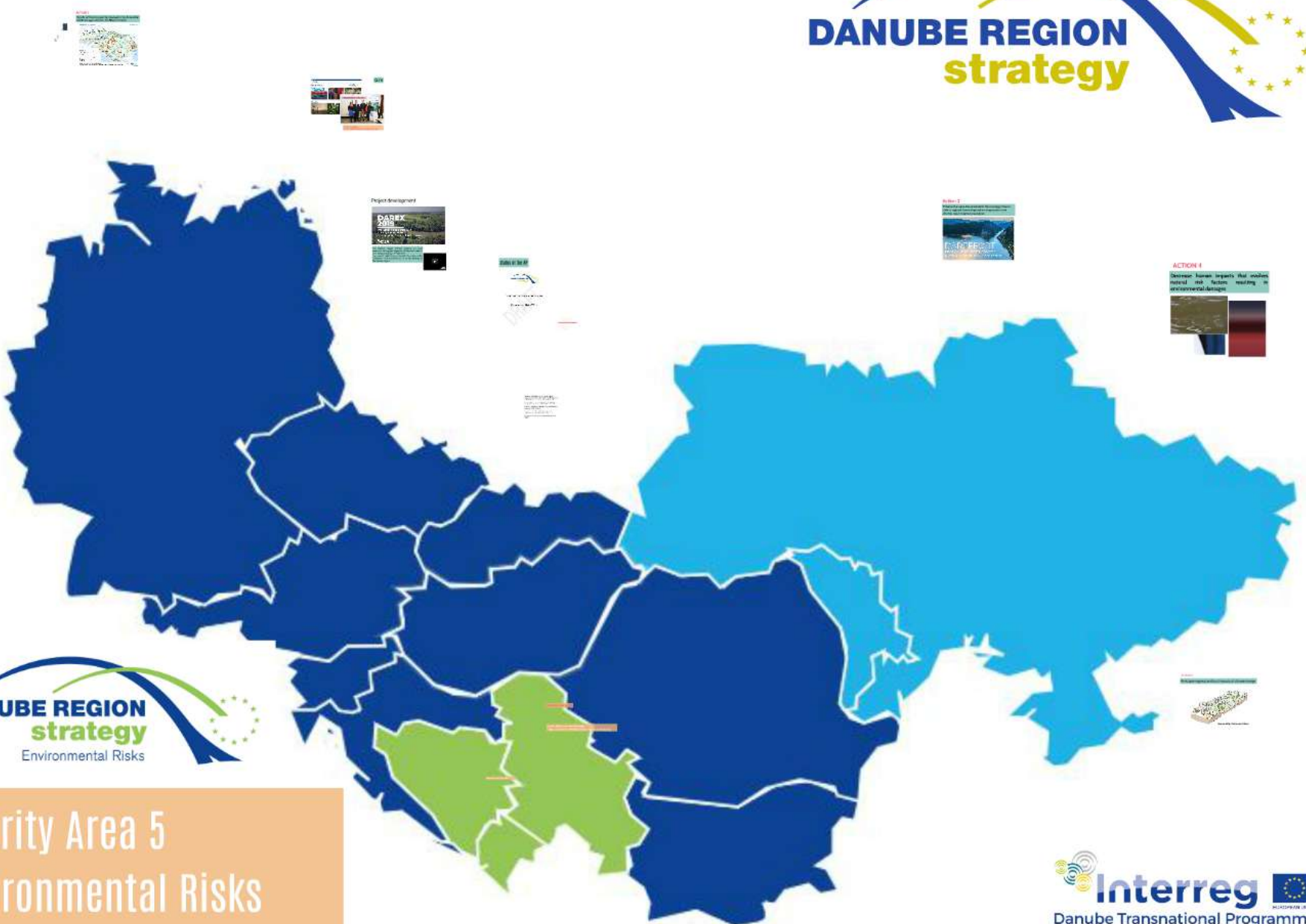

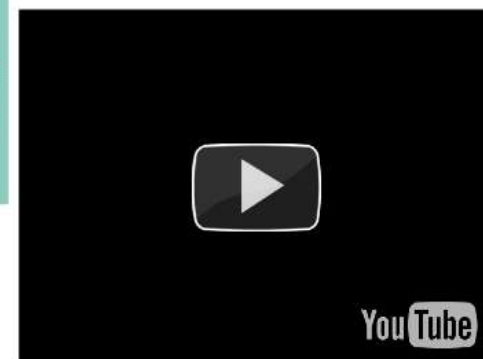

Operativ Flood Management Plan

Coordinate the operative flood management and civil protection plans in the Danube Basin. This includes the evacuation plans and procedures, safeguarding people, goods, emergency rescue plans, etc. considering the benefits of the civil protection mechanisms for the shared flood basins or stretches of common interest to better use the available resources.

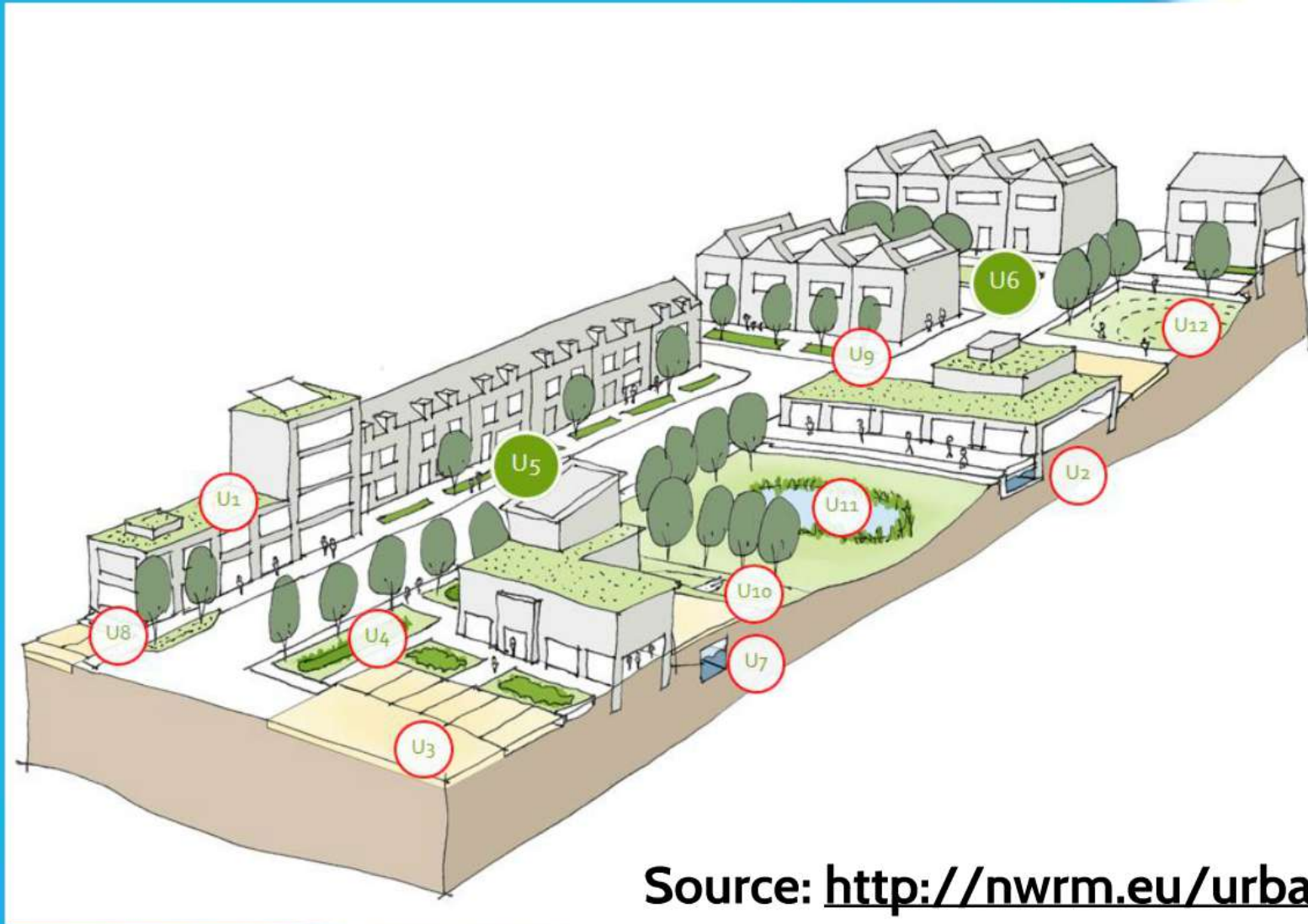
