LIFE PROGRAMME

- The only dedicated EU Programme for Environment and Climate Action.
 - Since 1992 more than 5500 projects supported, 1100 ongoing projects.
 - Overall objective is to contribute to the European Green Deal which aims to:

protect, conserve and enhance the EU's natural capital, and protect the health and well-being of citizens from environment and climate related risks and impacts.



Standard Action Projects 2021 call - insight

- Submissions via Funding & tender opportunities website
- <u>https://ec.europa.eu/info/funding-</u> tenders/opportunities/portal/screen/programmes/life2027
- New implementing agency: CINEA (European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency)
- One-stage submission: full project (previously two-stage submisson: 1. concept; 2. full project)
- Deadline was: 30 November 2021
- Deadline for CET projects: 12 January 2021
- Budget for ENV sub-programme: 100.420.656 € (50 ENV + 5 GOV projects)

Water related actions

- The **focus of water actions** will be on both **water quality and quantity management**, as well as **coastal and marine waters management**:
- integrated approaches for the implementation of the EU Water Framework Directive;
- actions targeted at the implementation of Floods Directive;
- actions targeted at the implementation of Marine Strategy Framework Directive;
- activities to ensure safe and efficient use of water resources, improving quantitative water management and resilience, preserving a high level of water quality and avoiding misuse and deterioration of water resources.







Water related actions

1. Water quality & quantity

- Improvement of water quality
- Implementation of **flood and/or drought risk management** actions
- Innovative projects addressing hydro morphological pressures identified in River Basin Management Plans and originating from land or water uses
- Implementation of **innovative water saving measures** in order to reduce the quantitative and qualitative pressures on water bodies/resources.

Water related actions

3. Water services

- Application of innovative technologies and tools for **drinking** water and urban wastewater treatment systems
- Application of innovative tools ensuring the **resource efficient provision of water services** compliant with the revised Drinking Water Directive and the Urban Waste Water Treatment Directive to population living in rural areas
- Improvement of the efficiency and effectiveness of innovative solutions and/or innovative **treatment options regarding recycled/reclaimed water**
